He developed, supervised and coordinated many international and European projects with large consortia (among them MUE25, CHAMP, Asian Cities Adapt, ecoBUDGET (Asia, Europe), EU Cities Adapt, DReAMS, Sustainable NOW, 100 Resilient Cities, EU Urban Transport Roadmap 2030, RAMSES etc.). Holger Robrecht is a renowned expert for sustainability management, resource efficiency, climate adaptation and ecosystem resilience and has been member of several international and EU Expert Groups, incl. ISO TC 268 'Sustainable Development of Communities' (since 2012), EU Expert Group for the Soil Thematic Strategy (2003) and the EU Work Group on Urban Environmental Management Plans and Systems (2004) and the EU Adaptation Steering Group (2010-2013).
