What have we learned?

- ENERGY TRANSITION REQUIRES SOCIAL TRANSITION
EG. LIFESTYLES, WORKING-LIFE
- DECENTRALISATION NEEDS LOCAL INVOLVEMENT
- COMPARING DIFFERENT COUNTRIES THE MAIN ACTOR CAN BE DIFFERENT:
NATIONAL LEVEL: GERMANY
STATE LEVEL: USA
LOCAL LEVEL (BIG CITIES): INDIA

How can we contribute to local climate action?

- STAKEHOLDER PARTICIPATION ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT ON LOCAL LEVEL
- INTERNAL INCENTIVES NECESSARY FOR LOCAL LEVEL
E.G. SHOWCASE COMMUNITIES IN USA
NATIONAL CLIMATE INITIATIVE IN GERMANY

- ENERGY TRANSITION NEEDS NEW BUSINESS CONCEPTS
- ENABLING LOCAL LEVELS FOR NEW FORMS OF ORGANISING ENTERPRISES (E.G. "ENERGIEGENOSSEN-SCHAFTEN")
- FOSTERING EXCHANGE AMONG ~~SPARE~~ SPEARHEADS ON LOCAL LEVEL E.G. BIG CITIES IN AN INTERNATIONAL FORMAT
