### What have we learned?

- \* Complex issue that addresses several policy areas: environment, labour, social, finance, education
- \* transformation requires trust
- \* behavioural change is key
- ⇒ Obstacles: missing awareness, financing (subsidies), cultural differences, trust, emotional reach
- ⇒ Success factors: target group has more urgent needs, energy as a contribution to fight poverty, participation, emotional reach, eye level consultants

### How can we contribute to local climate action?

- \* not only technologies but <sup>pers</sup> human being → motivation → \* investment priorities match community needs
- \* Urbanisation ⇒ high pressure on local level → enabling municipalities \* partnerships with local partners
- \* integrative views ⇒ integrate all departments, actors on local level
- \* integrate the social dimension into the climate action agenda and funding programs for local authorities

### Next Steps?

- \* piggy back / leverage climate actions to the social dimension of communities
- \* climate action becomes a local government service
- \* Enable local authorities to address inclusive climate action by competences, financial resources ~~mandates~~, mandates, staff capacity, policy instruments, tools
